## Discussion of Worship/Sanctuary Ideas

#### From Rev. Gord Dunbar

- 1. The Committee discussed the idea and implementation of an Education/Explanation format of the reason behind each part of the liturgy during Sunday Worship. An explanation of the reason for each part of the liturgy will be put in the bulletin and on the screens. A town hall meeting of the congregation will be offered, immediately after a worship service, for their feedback once the education/explanation has been completed.
- 2. The committee discussed the suggestion of not passing the Offering Plates during the service but rather leave the plates at the back of the sanctuary. This is being perceived as a more welcoming action and where it has been done in other churches there was no perceived difference in the donations. There would still be a time of dedication. A trial was suggested beginning June 3, 2018.

## From Judy Zarubick

- 1. The new choir chairs are being ordered as there have been enough donations made to cover their cost. The Programme Committee approved taking out the first long pew in the Choir Loft and moving the rail back to allow more space. Judy Zarubick will see that the removal is done.
- 2. It has been noted that the front of the chancel is very crowded. The short flower stands may be better used for the speakers so that the choir can hear properly. The flowers could be put on the taller flower stands that are available throughout the church. The committee suggested that any change to the chancel, be looked at after the arrival of the Choir Chairs and the removal of the church pew.
